● Hjørring Kaserne

Hjørring har siden 1939 år været garnisonsby. Kaserne, der dækker et areal på 47 ha, hvoraf halvdelen er skov, har gennem tiden huset en række forskellige enheder, men er i dag vært for fem forskellige værnsmæssige tjenester: Forsvarets Materieltjeneste, Forsvarets Koncernfælles Informatiktjeneste, Forsvarets Personeltjeneste, Forsvarets Regnskabs- og Etablisementstjeneste og Forsvarets Bygnings- og Etablisementstjeneste. De fem tjenester beskæftiger tilsammen godt 900 militære og civile ansatte, hvis hovedopgave er at støtte de operative enheder i forsvaret.

Forsvarets Personeltjeneste, Forsvarets Regnskabs- og Etablisementstjeneste og Forsvarets Bygnings- og Etablisementstjeneste beskæftiger i Hjørring tilsammen godt 750 ansatte. Deres hovedopgave er at støtte de operative enheder i internationale operationer.



Forsvarets Personeltjeneste

Forsvarets Personeltjeneste varetager den individuelle rådgivning, forvaltning og kompetenceudvikling af Forsvarets medarbejdere, løser værnepligts- og rekrutteringsopgaver samt forestår administrative opgaver inden for personel- og lønområdet.

Forsvarets Materieltjeneste

Forsvarets Materieltjeneste varetager indkøb og servicering af forsvarets materiel herunder køretøjer, skibe og luftfartøjer. FMT er spredt over hele landet og har på Hjørring Kaserne værkstedsfaciliteter og lagerbygninger, som benyttes af Værksted Danmark Vest og Forsvarets Depot og Distribution.

Forsvarets Regnskabs- og Etablisementstjeneste

Forsvarets Regnskabs- og Etablisementstjeneste står for regnskabet i Forsvaret og sørger herunder for pengeforsyning i hele organisationen. FRT registrerer og overvåger de

regnskabsmæssige transaktioner inden for indkøb, salg og rejsevirkomhed, varetager bogholderi- og kassevirkomhed samt udvikler forsvarets regnskabsmodel og -systemer til fremtidens behov.

Forsvarets Bygnings- og Etablisementstjeneste

Forsvarets Bygnings- og Etablisementstjenestes hovedopgave er at udvikle, drive og levere bygninger og serviceværestab for forsvaret. FBE varetager således alle Forsvarets bygge-, anlægs- og vedligeholdelsesprojekter samt selve driften af alle Forsvarets etableringer, herunder, kantinedrift, rengøring og arealpleje.

En alsidig arbejdsplads

Det brede faglige spændingsfelt samt blandingen af civil og militært personale gør Hjørring Kaserne til en dynamisk og alsidig arbejdsplads, der byder på spændende udfordringer og oplevelser af både international, national og lokal karakter. Det er en arbejdsplads, der er i konstant bevægelse, fordi Forsvaret hele tiden må være på forkant med udviklingen i resten af samfundet. Det stiller krav til vores medarbejdere om forandringsparathed, fleksibilitet og livslang læring.

Hjørring Kaserne og dens medarbejdere har altid spillet en væsentlig rolle for lokalsamfundet og vil også i fremtiden være en aktiv og åben organisation, der inviterer befolkningen ind bag hegnet.

● Hjørring Barracks

Since 1939 Hjørring has been a garrison town. Hjørring Barracks cover an area of 47 hectares and half of the area is covered with forest. Over the years, the Barracks have been a base for several units of Danish Defence, and today four of Danish Defence's new services are placed at Hjørring Barracks. The five services – the Danish Defence Acquisition and Logis-



tics Organization, the Danish Defence Personnel Service, the Danish Defence Accounting Service and the Danish Defence Estates and Infrastructure Organization – provide work for more than 900 military and civilian employees. Their main task is to support the operative units in the Danish Defence.

The Defence Personnel Service

The Defence Personnel Service handles the individual consultancy, administration and competence development of Danish Defence employees, solves military service and recruitment tasks and is responsible for strategic tasks within the HR area.

The Defence Accounting Service

The Defence Accounting Service is responsible for all Danish Defence accounting and for distributing financial resources throughout the entire organisation. The Defence Accounting Service registers and monitors financial transactions within purchasing, sales and travel, carries out bookkeeping and cash control



and develops Danish Defence's accounting model and systems to meet future requirements.

The Danish Defence Acquisition and Logistics Organization

The Danish Defence Acquisition and Logistics Organization is responsible for the purchase and maintenance of Danish Defence equipment including vehicles, ships and aircrafts. The Danish Defence Acquisition and Logistics Organization is located across Denmark, and at Hjørring Barracks the organization has garage facilities and storehouses.

Danish Defence Estates and Infrastructure Organization

The main task of the Danish Defence Estates and Infrastructure Organization is developing and supplying facilities to Danish Defence's other authorities. Thus, the service carries out all Danish Defence's construction, plant and maintenance projects as well

as running Danish Defence's establishments; this includes canteen operations, cleaning and looking after outdoor areas.

The extensive professional interaction and the mix of civil and military staff makes Hjørring Barracks a dynamic and varied workplace which offers exciting challenges and experiences that are international, national and local in character. It is a workplace where things are always on the move because Danish Defence always needs to head developments in relation to society at large. A lot is expected of our employees in terms of their readiness for change, flexibility and lifelong learning.

Hjørring Barracks and its employees have always played a key role within the local community, and will continue to be an active and open organisation that is happy to show people living nearby what happens behind the scenes.
